

# Regional Steering Committee on Homelessness

## VISION

<b>Vision</b>	To eliminate homelessness in Greater Vancouver through the full implementation of the Regional Homelessness Plan: Three Ways to Home.
<b>Mission</b>	To inspire and lead a co-ordinated response to homelessness in the region.
<b>Principles</b>	<p>The Regional Steering Committee on Homelessness (RSCH) carries out its mission through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Encouraging regional solutions to homelessness;</li><li>• Collaboration with partners;</li><li>• Inclusion of the diverse needs and interests reflected in the current homeless and “at risk” population; and,</li><li>• Promotion of positive change at the community level and within all levels and agencies of government.</li></ul>
<b>Committee Structure</b>	The RSCH is a coalition of community organizations and all levels of government. Membership diversity is a key asset of the Committee and links to local and regional homeless committees are strong. The work of the RSCH is supported by working groups and subcommittees, and is guided by Terms of Reference found in the Governance Manual.
<b>Reporting Responsibility</b>	The RSCH is contractually responsible to its funding partners; however, just as importantly, the Committee is accountable to those it serves: people who are homeless or “at risk”, those working directly to respond to homelessness, and the wider community.
